The relationship started over 20 years ago between the two Presidents; Bruce Coxhead (ZWES) and William Rickard (GCCL) from previous companies. ZWES needed a solid manufacturing group that offered quality, speed and integration of equipment to production lines where necessary. To date GCCL has built all the sizes of our **revolution**TM waste processors for distribution in the Americas.



General Conveyor Co. Ltd., founded in 1948, and its daughter company GenCon Fabrication are privately owned Canadian companies based in Aurora, Ontario - about 20 minutes north of Toronto. The GCCL product line includes all types of conveyor systems, packaging machinery, palletizer/ depalletizer equipment, robotic automation systems, innovative system integration, advanced technology distribution, qualified technical support, and service of all supplied equipment. Their primary focus is in the food, personal care, pharmaceutical, beverage, irradiation, plastics and warehousing industries.

Zero Waste Energy Systems was founded in 2005 and in 2010, acquired the global rights to a unique waste processor developed in the UK to extract liquids from industrial wastes destined for land fill sites in Europe. With the onset of the European Landfill Directive in the late 90's, de-liquefaction has become a legal responsibility for wastes

headed for landfill. ZWES has purchased these rights and is setting up manufacturing and distribution in the Americas where similar restrictions on liquids and organics are coming on-stream. As of 2011, Toronto's garbage is no longer being hauled to Michigan, leaving a significant need in Ontario as well as other Provinces and States for this type of advanced technology.
